

How to prepare for the Finnish Immigration Service (Migri) at Saariselkä and Levi

The need to apply for EU-registration is for those **EU-citizens** who are in Finland **more than 3 months continuously**. All applicants must fill and pay the electronic application in Enter Finland. Paper applications are not accepted. More information about the EU-registration, please see <u>Registration of right of residence</u> | <u>Maghanmuuttovirasto</u>.

Since the amount off applicants is big during the visit, Migri will only handle the EU-citizens identifications during the visit. This means that the application will not be handled during the visit, but Migri will check your passport/ID and that you have the electronic application. This way you will not need an appointment at the Service Point in Rovaniemi.

The application will be activated later that week. If we have any questions of something is missing, Migri will contact you through Enter Finland. The decision will be done later and you will get the decision to your Enter Finland account.

Before you start filling the Enter Finland application make sure you have all the needed documents:

- scan of your passport/ID (you can take a photo, but make sure the photo is sharp and readable)
- scan of your work contract (you can take a photo, but make sure the photo is sharp and readable)

Migri's officer cannot scan anything to your Enter Finland account.

Fill the application, attach the documents, pay the application fee (61€) and send the application. You can find the application from the link above or by following the instructions on the other attachment (Applying for EU registration via Enter Finland).

Take your passport/ID with you to the visit.
